Responsibilities:

- Communicate any significant injury or illness to the Executive and Camp Director immediately to ensure that parents are informed and that a practitioner is called, and nurse if necessary.
- Help children and staff with physical or emotional problems with prayerful ideas and encourage them to turn to a Christian Science Practitioner for treatment if applicable.
- Facilitate smooth handling of laundry by communicating which days laundry is picked up and returned. Aid in gathering cabin laundry bags and then distributing clean laundry. Help to locate misplaced articles, repair clothing when necessary, or make sewing equipment available to campers and staff.
- Assist with Quiet Hour (when requested) in addition to wake-up and bedtime
- Teach a Sunday School class if requested by Camp Director.
- Take charge of a table at meals in the dining hall if requested by Camp Director.
- Keep Bena/Nosoni (Camp Parent facilities) ready for use by campers or staff.
- When possible, visit various daily activities to express interest and support.
- Attend evening activities such as the campfire night, barn dance, and talent show, as well as all-camp activities.
- Watch campers during 6pm staff meetings and 10pm staff meetings→ be on the gamefield before meal-times, specifically during the 6pm staff meeting spot. At the 10pm staff meeting, follow directions from the Camp Director as to where to be stationed.
