- Assist Facilities Manager with building improvement projects and repairs on buildings when a second person is needed.
- Pick up and dispose of waste from various receptacles around camp daily.
- Mow lawns and take care of other landscaping needs.
- Assist the Facilities Manager in maintaining a clean and tidy workshop facility.
- Assist with the care, fueling, and safety checks of camp vehicles and machinery, after receiving training in their use and in what safety checks are to be carried out.
- Support the implementation of ACA standards about facilities.
- Assist with camp security, such as locking gate or patrolling facility.
- Carry out any other facility maintenance projects as assigned by the Facilities Manager.
- Assist program staff in the setup or breakdown of equipment or furniture needed for special events.
- In the event of a fire or flood or other emergency that affects the camp's facilities, work with the Facilities Manager to contain and limit damage to the physical facilities.
